



## DIRECTIVE 2010/65/EU Reporting Formalities Directive RFD

- To simplify and harmonise administrative procedures applied to maritime transport.
- Member States shall accept the fullfilment of reporting formalities in electronic format, and their transmission via single window, no later than 1 june 2015.
- All information is reported once and in one place.
- And made available to different competent authorities and other Member States.
- Information received based on reporting formalities provided in a legal act
  of the Union shall be made available in SafeSeaNet (SSN).

<u>Electronic transmission of data</u> means the process of transmitting information that has been <u>encoded digitally</u>, using a <u>revisable structured</u> format which can be used directly for storage and processing by computers No faxes, pdf, scans, ...

## SPANISH NATIONAL MARITIME SINGLE WINDOW from 5 may 2015





