





## Puertos del Estado and Miami-Dade explore possible collaborations

 The County delegation, headed by its mayor, Carlos Giménez, is interested in the success stories of the Spanish port system applicable to its territory

In the work meeting held yesterday by Puertos del Estado and the Miami-Dade County delegation, logistical solutions were explored for the future development of this US port based on the experiences developed in Spanish ports.

Other points of common interest addressed by both delegations were related to the interconnection between port, airport, rail and road infrastructure, the efficient and rapid management of goods under Security and Safety criteria and adapting infrastructure to the sector's new challenges, both for the transfer of cruise passengers through the port and to service supercarriers.
