The export of Spanish produce, representing more than 2 million tons of fruit, vegetables and legumes, grew by 14% in 2019. Spain's ports offer a wide range of connections and services at the Fruit Logistica Fair

More than 12 million tons in fruit and vegetable produce have passed through Spain's ports

- Bahía de Algeciras, Valencia, Barcelona, Las Palmas and S.C. Tenerife accounted for almost 85% of the port traffic in fruit and vegetable produce in 2019.
- 14 Spanish ports, coordinated by Puertos del Estado, will offer their services and facilities at Europe's largest fair in the sector.

Spain has become one of Europe's leading suppliers of fruit, vegetables and legumes, both homegrown and produce in transit, from other continents en route to third countries. Thus, provisional closing figures for **2019** reflect total traffic of more than 12 million tons of fruit and vegetable produce, representing a 4% increase over last year. Of this amount, more than 2 million tons referred to exports of Spanish produce, which increased by 14%, and 5.5 million (+13.4%) represented produce in transit.

According to the latest data published by FEPEX, the Spanish Federation of Associations of Fruit & Vegetable Exporters and Producers, in 2018 more than 12.5 million tons of Spanish produce were exported, generating revenues of 12,832 million Euros. That same year, nearly 12% of such exports- more than 1.6 million tons- were delivered by sea; the most active ports were Valencia, S.C. Tenerife, Las Palmas, Bahía de Algeciras, Barcelona, Bilbao and Bahía de Cádiz, as they gathered close to 88% of all port traffic.
